

FIRE CHIEF OF THE YEAR AWARD
Award Criteria

One award will be given to a chief officer each year.

Individuals who are eligible for nomination and selection as Fire Chief of the Year are not limited to chief

Selection criteria will emphasize leadership, innovation, professional development, integrity, service to the

Once a chief has been selected as the Fire Chief of the Year, he or she shall not be eligible to be nomin

There will be a standard format for the nominations to include:

- The Official nomination form
-

A cover letter on the organization's letterhead, signed by the president, chief or under chief, d

-

A current resume detailing the candidate's involvement in the fire service.

-

A minimum of three other documents supporting the candidate's nomination, newspaper articles, or letters of apprec

-

The nomination and selection process is:

-

A fire department or any member of the New Jersey State Fire Chiefs' Association can nominate a mem

-

The person making the nomination is responsible to notify the candidate and determine that he or she is

-

The nomination package shall be submitted to the Secretary of the New Jersey State Fire Chiefs' Assoc

-

The winner shall be selected by a special committee appointed by the President of the New Jersey State

-

The Fire Chief of the Year Award shall be presented at the Annual Meeting by the President.

- The form of the Award shall be determined by the Board of Directors.
